Comments: (moku hanga) A Boteh is a curving, leaf-like shape used as a design element and originating in Persia. It is believed to derive from a stylized leaf or cypress tree, but fig and wings have also been suggested. Indian embroidered shawls

employing this design became fashionable in the 1800\'s and the town of Paisley would become famous for printing cotton fabrics based on Indian embroidered scarves with this design. My wife, for many years, wore her waist-length hair in a wiry, long, tangled braid and I suggest in this woodblock print a different origin for this antique design.
